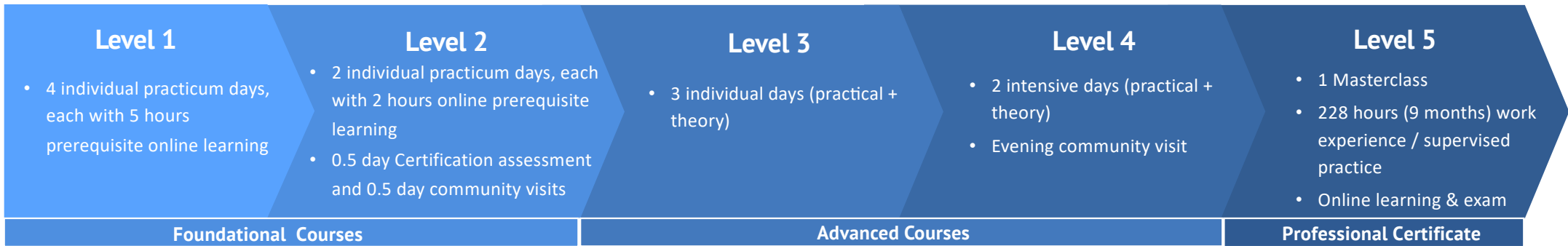


Canine Assisted Interactions Certification Process

Certificate in Animal Assisted Interventions Canine



Level 1: Learner Dog & Certified Provisional Handler

Provisional Handlers understand the necessary OH&S, welfare and organisational requirements of CAI. They can plan and administer programmes, and prepare & socialise their dog for full Visiting Certification.



Level 2: Certified Visiting Dog & Handler Team

Certified Handlers facilitate safe interactions benefiting clients and dogs within the workplace. Certified dogs are responsive on lead and genuinely enjoy people.

Level 3: Advanced Course Preparation & Theory

Certified Handlers develop knowledge of the neurobiology of interactions and can develop creative goal focused intervention plans. Dogs begin training in off leash skills, tricks and small agility.



Level 4: Certified Advanced Therapy / School Dog & Handler Team

Advanced Handlers develop & deliver goal focused and creative interventions. Advanced dogs are highly responsive and can work off lead with clients, in complex settings.



Level 5: Certified Practitioner In AAT, AAE or AAA & Certificate in AAI Canine

Practitioners effectively combine CAI theory and practice within their primary occupation as a specialist scope of practice modality (e.g., mental health, education, allied health).
